

The Elks National Foundation is a permanent, charitable, and philanthropic fund of our order. This message indicates the principles of the fund which has increased not only through the generous additional gifts of members, Lodges and others, and bequests of members and nonmembers who approve National Foundation Philanthropies, but also through wise investment under guidance of investment counsel. National Foundation trustees wish you to know that no part of the principal fund is EVER distributed for any purpose: that the income earned by investment of the fund is used to carry on the good works to which the fund is dedicated.

The Elks National Foundation sponsors educational scholarship grants to students who are outstanding in scholarship and leadership accomplishments, character, citizenship, and extra curricular activities and who may be in financial need. No student is entitled to receive more than one Elks National Foundation Scholarship nor are the grants automatically renewable.

The Elks National Foundation is administered by a Board of Trustees consisting of seven members of the Grand Lodge, appointed by the Grand Exalted Ruler and confirmed by the Grand Lodge. They receive no compensation for their services. The administrative expenses of the foundation are defrayed by an annual appropriation from general fund of the Grand Lodge.


